Beaver River- Porter 115kV Transmission Rebuild Project

Construction Commencement Notice | September 2026

We are writing you to inform you that construction activities for the Beaver River- Porter 115kV Transmission Rebuild Project will start on or about September 10, 2026

We're building a smarter, stronger energy grid to deliver a more resilient energy network for our customers. Our work, taking place across Upstate New York, is called the **Upstate Upgrade**. It involves more than 70 projects through 2030 that will transform the transmission grid to meet growing demand for electricity while generating thousands of new jobs and more than \$1 billion in economic growth across the region. In Lewis County, this work includes replacing the existing electric transmission line and building a new substation in the Town of Croghan.

The overall project involves site preparation, construction and restoration for the removal and rebuilding of a 115kV overhead electric transmission line between Croghan and Marcy. For the current phase of the project, the new Beaver River substation will be built in Croghan and include civil work, installation of substation equipment, and restoration.

Schedule

Construction for the Beaver River substation is anticipated to begin on or about September 10, 2026, and is scheduled to be completed by Winter 2030. Work will be completed in phases and there may be periods of inactivity throughout the project. We will send additional notices for future phases of the project.

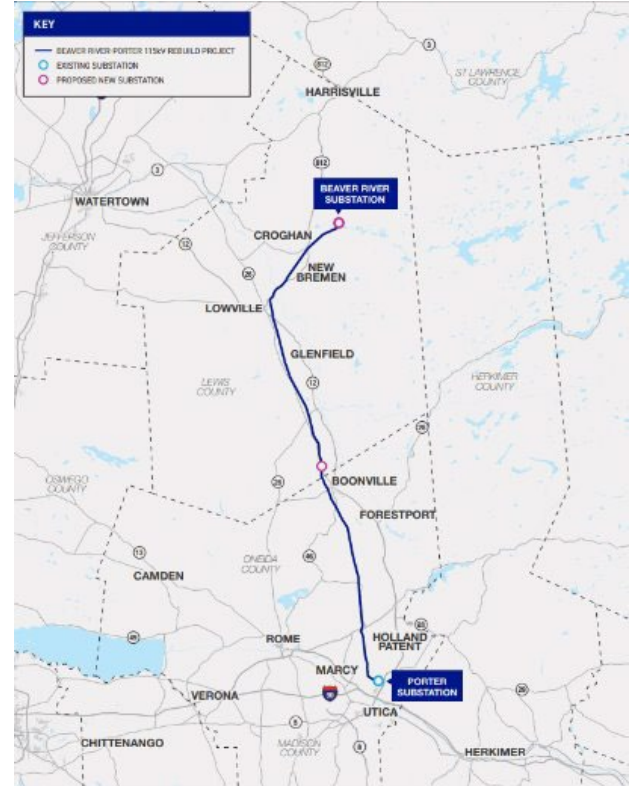
Keeping safety is a priority
